The joint National Conference on Urban Entomology (NCUE) and Invasive Pest Ant (IPA) Conference will be held 19-22 May 2024 in Mobile, AL. The NCUE/IPA Awards Committee requests the nomination of individuals from academia, government, or industry who have made outstanding and significant contributions to the field of urban entomology. The recipient of the 2024 Distinguished Achievement Award will present the **Arnold Mallis Memorial Award Lecture** during the conference. In addition, the NCUE Planning Committee has established a monetary award for the recipient. A check and commemorative plaque will be presented to the recipient at the time of the Mallis Lecture.

Nominations for the Distinguished Achievement Award should be made in the form of a 2-3 page letter summarizing the nominee's qualifications, accomplishments, and contributions to urban entomology. Additional supporting documents (letters of support, curriculum vitae, etc.) are encouraged with total documentation not to exceed 8 pages. Selection will be based on the total contributions of the nominee.
