SUBJECT: Call for Applications, Student Scholarship Awards

The joint National Conference on Urban Entomology (NCUE) and Invasive Pest Ant (IPA) Conference will be held **19-22 May 2024 in Mobile, AL**. The NCUE/IPA Awards Committee requests applications from students who are interested in scholarship award of \$1500 plus complimentary registration for NCUE/IPA. If qualified, three scholarships will be awarded – one each at the Ph.D., M.S., and B.S. levels. All recipient(s) of the **2024 Student Scholarship Awards** will present during the conference, and the check and a plaque will be presented to winners at the conference Awards Luncheon.

Applicants must be graduate or undergraduate students performing research in urban entomology or industrial pest management full-time at a US college or university. The applicant must have at least 2 months remaining in his/her degree program from the deadline of this application (16 February 2024). Application packets must include the following:

1. Applicant information, including name, mailing address, phone number, and email.
2. Transcripts (unofficial copies are acceptable).
3. At least one letter of recommendation (three maximum).
4. Maximum of five additional pages of supporting documents (e.g., CV, research proposals, list of publications, etc.) that may be helpful in the selection process.
5. Submission to mekeck@ag.tamu.edu by the end of the day on **16 February 2024**.

Students may apply for both the **NCUE/IPA Student Scholarship Award** and one of the **Student Travel Awards**, but the presentation for each *must be unique*.

Nomination packets must be submitted to ncue.awards@gmail.com by the end of the day on 16 February 2024 to be considered.
